Cooper Crouse-Hinds B.V – The Netherlands and the WEEE Directive

The EC directive on Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) (SI 2006 no 3289) came into effect in the The Netherlands on August 13, 2005.

The Directive aims to minimize the impact of electrical and electronic goods on the environment, by increasing re-use and recycling and reducing the amount of WEEE going to landfill.

In scope Cooper Crouse-Hinds products produced since 13th August 2005 have been marked with a crossed out wheelie bin underlined with a thick black line -



and one of the identification marks as illustrated below -



Cooper Crouse-Hinds B.V. is responsible for the treatment, disposal and wherever possible recycling of all products produced since that date.

Cooper Crouse-Hinds B.V. has registered through Lightrec / NVMP The Netherlands as a producer of Non Household WEEE. Thus disposal of WEEE products is ensured.

Our WEEE producer registration number is: NL 1539

In compliance with the legislation Cooper Crouse-Hinds B.V. will also accept back for disposal on a like for like basis any Historic WEEE of any manufacture (Products produced before 13th August 2005, identified by the lack of the thick black line under the crossed out wheelie bin).

This applies where new Cooper Crouse-Hinds B.V. products have replaced the equivalent amount of historic WEEE products. If any Historic WEEE is to be returned this must be advised prior to our acceptance of the order and a method and period agreed for the return of this waste.
