The WEEE Register

Electrical and electronic equipment (EE equipment) can contain environmentally hazardous substances. These products shall be collected separately and treated properly when they end up as waste. To ensure separate collection, sorting and treatment, the Norwegian regulations relating to the recycling of waste (Waste Regulations) contains separate provisions on EE waste.

The WEEE Register is established and owned by the Norwegian Pollution Control Authority (SFT) and operated by Norsas AS (the Norwegian Resource Centre for Waste Management and Recycling).

In scope Cooper Crouse-Hinds A/S products produced since 13th August 2005 have been marked with a crossed out wheelie bin underlined with a thick black line -



and one of the identification marks as illustrated below -



As we are obliged to take responsibility for our products until they have been scrapped and recycled we are member of a non-profit organisation, RENAS, who fulfils these obligations on behalf of the members. We have been member since October 12th 1999.

The responsibility for the actual collection and treatment of EE waste lies upon the take-back companies. The Waste Regulations imposes several duties on these take-back companies.
